Dear Mr. Gotbaum:

We are writing to seek a status update on the work plan for the Delphi pension plans assumed by the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation's (PBGC) on August 25, 2009, and to request an estimated timeframe for the notification of final benefit determinations. On September 11, 2009, you provided our offices with a work plan for the Delphi pension plans, which outlined the administration of information for plan participants.

In the aftermath of the Delphi bankruptcy, salaried workers, hourly employees under non-United Auto Worker (UAW) contracts, and other former Delphi employees, are facing different outcomes with respect to their pensions. It is essential that PBGC take proactive measures to ensure that each group of worker and retirees has clear and accurate information about the pension benefits they will receive.

We appreciate the hours and work you and your staff has already dedicated to this and other pension plans, and we recognize that the calculation of final benefit determinations is a challenging and time consuming endeavor.
