MINUTE ORDER. In light of the parties' arguments and for reasons stated on the record at the hearing, the Court enters the following briefing schedule for Treasury's motion to reconsider the Court's [44] April 13, 2017 Order:

Treasury's motion for reconsideration shall be filed no later than May 22, 2017; respondents' response shall be filed no later than May 31, 2017; and Treasury's reply shall be filed no later than June 5, 2017.

The parties' briefing should address, inter alia, (1) whether respondents have adequately made a "showing of need" for documents otherwise protected under the presidential-communications privilege; and (2) the standard by which the Court should determine, during an in camera inspection, whether the documents at issue are "relevant" to respondents' case.

The portion of the Court's [44] April 13, 2017 Order directing that documents over which Treasury has asserted the presidential-communications privilege be "forthwith produced" is hereby vacated.
