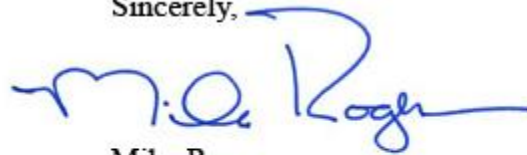
Dear Mr. Begley:

Thank you for taking the time to contact me regarding your serious concerns with the treatment of salaried Delphi retirees. It is good to hear from you.

I share your frustration and outrage. It is clear that salaried retirees from Delphi and also from General Motors and Chrysler, have been treated differently than retirees with union representation. That is why I have repeatedly asked the President's Auto Task Force, the people who decided to push GM and Chrysler into a bankruptcy proceeding that pitted retirees, workers, suppliers and dealers against each other, to explain themselves and to rectify the situation. I regret to inform you that so far an adequate response has not been provided.
