On Thursday, August 12, 2010 you were gracious enough to visit the Mahoning Valley in Northeastern Ohio. We hope you enjoyed meeting our constituents as much as they enjoyed you.

As you recall, you met with two members of the Delphi Salaried Retirees Association (DSRA), Bruce Gump and Mary Ann Hudzik, who voiced their concerns regarding the unresolved situation of the salaried pension benefits. As you may know, there is ongoing litigation concerning this issue. We are not asking you to intervene in the litigation process. However, our constituents who have been affected by this would truly appreciate your assistance in facilitating discussions between representatives for the Delphi retirees and the appropriate parties within the Department of Treasury.

Though you clearly stated that their best recourse lies in a legal settlement, you kindly offered to reach out to Treasury Secretary Tim Geithner for assistance. The purpose of this letter is to follow up on that commitment, and to request that should you be successful in securing a meeting, we will help in any way.
