On behalf of our Mississippi constituents, we write to thank you for the field hearing you held on November 14, 2011, in Dayton, Ohio, to hear testimony from Delphi salaried retirees whose pension benefits were greatly reduced at the recommendation of the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation in 2009. We support the efforts of the House Committee on Oversight & Government Reform in examining this matter.

This is another significant step in learning why Delphi salaried retirees were treated differently than their union counterparts. It is important to determine whether the federal government, acting through General Motors, picked winners and losers in the GM bankruptcy proceedings. All retirees must be treated in a fair and equitable manner.

We appreciate your continued commitment to investigating the disparities in the treatment of pensions between the Delphi Corporation's hourly—and salary-based employees, and like you, we look forward to the resolution of this issue for Delphi retirees.
