Dear Director Gotbaum:

I am writing on behalf of one of the constituents I serve, Mr. Gil Putt, who recently contacted you to request that the Pension Benefit Guarantee Corporation (PBGC) officials meet with representatives from the Delphi Salaried Retirees Association (DSRA) to discuss a proposal for restoring the pension benefits of Delphi salaried retirees. I have included a copy of Mr. Putt's original letter, and I ask for your full consideration to grant his request.

In his letter to you, Mr. Putt referenced a July 9, 2012 letter from Senator Debbie Stabenow and Senator Sherrod Brown, addressed to President Barack Obama, that included the DSRA proposal for restoring the drastically cut pension benefits that had been promised to Delphi salaried retirees, and also requested that President Obama's Administration meet with DSRA representatives to discuss their proposal. It is my understanding that, to date, no such meeting or consideration of their proposal has taken place.

Former workers and their families have suffered a great deal as a result of the Delphi plant closures, and the inconsistent treatment of pension benefit plans has added further uncertainty to their situation. The time for the more than 20,000 Delphi retirees and their families to receive answers and clarity to their situation has long since passed, and I am hopeful that a positive resolution can be brought to these issues as quickly as possible.

Again, I look forward to your response to Mr. Putt's letter to meet with him and DSRA representatives to discuss their proposal for restoring the pension benefits of Delphi salaried employees.
