Dear Mr. Secretary,

On a recent visit to the Youngstown area, I met with some employees of the Delphi Company, who are concerned about unfairness in the pension system – an issue I know you understand fully. Three of my Ohio colleagues, Senator Brown and Representatives Ryan and Wilson, have written to me recently asking me to urge that appropriate officials from the Treasury Department meet with them to listen to their views. Given the understandable unhappiness of these hardworking people at what clearly was an unfairness, no matter who was responsible for it, I think it would be beneficial if Treasury officials could meet with them. I do believe that in the end they will receive the wage they want only through litigation, but there is of course no harm whatsoever in having officials meet with them and maybe there are things that could come out of it that would be useful. They certainly are people deserving of every consideration we can give them, given what has happened to them.

If there are appropriate officials with whom they should be in contact, I would appreciate it if you would let me know.
